“Now Playing” uses movies to help kids learn Bible stories and biblical concepts and give kids tools to be able to apply what they learn to their everyday lives. As Jesus spoke in parables to help many understand his teachings, we use popular (and sometimes not so popular) kids movies to do the same.

What to expect:

- Watching part of a movie (no more than 25 minutes altogether), typically in two segments. (Movies are rated PG and lower and are screened and edited as needed).
- Reading Scripture passages about the story being discussed.
- A game or other activity to engage kids and introduce concepts.
- Discussions about the film being viewed and relating it heavily to the story/biblical concept being taught.
- Discussions about how to apply what we learned to our everyday lives.
- Prayer.
