

## BAREL

- THE WORD "BEGINNING" IN GENESIS 1:1 IS THE HEBREW WORD "RE'SHIYTH (RAY-SHEETH')" WHICH MEANS "FIRST, BEGINNING, BEST, CHIEF."
  - THE CREATION STORY WAS BOTH FIRST IN TIMELINE ORDER AND FIRST IN IMPORTANCE IN THE BIBLICAL NARRATIVE.
- After Creation, God saw that his creation was good. He trusted the story.
- Adam and Eve were the first humans and the only part of creation made "imago dei" or "in the image of God."
- Several generations after Adam and Eve (and exactly 1,656 years after Adam was created), God sent a flood that wiped out all life on earth except the life that was in a boat.
  - THAT BOAT WAS NOAH'S ARK
- Generations after Noah, people decided to stay in one spot and build a tower.
  - o Technology was advancing quickly we see that in the creation of the bricks and the ambition of building such a big structure.
  - o The people did not trust in the goodness of God's story.
    - They did not fill the earth as God commanded.
    - THEY WANTED TO MAKE A NAME FOR THEMSELVES INSTEAD OF HUMBLING THEMSELVES BEFORE GOD.
- GOD CONFUSED THE LANGUAGES OF THE PEOPLE TO DISPERSE THEM AND STOP THEM FROM COMPLETING THE TASK OF BUILDING A GIANT TOWER.
  - GOD SPECIFICALLY MADE NOTE OF HOW HUMANS WOULD HAVE SUCCEEDED AT BUILDING THIS TOWER AND IT WOULD HAVE ONLY BEEN THE BEGINNING OF WHAT HUMANS WOULD DO TOGETHER.
    - With such success and power, humans would have likely been overcome with pride and unable to realize their need for God.
  - After the languages were confused, people spread out over the face of the whole earth.
  - This is why it was called "Babel."
