

## ISAAC

- THE WORD "BEGINNING" IN GENESIS 1:1 IS THE HEBREW WORD "RE'SHIYTH (RAY-SHEETH')" WHICH MEANS "FIRST, BEGINNING, BEST, CHIEF."
  - THE CREATION STORY WAS BOTH FIRST IN TIMELINE ORDER AND FIRST IN IMPORTANCE IN THE BIBLICAL NARRATIVE.
- After Creation, God saw that his creation was good. He trusted the story.
- Abraham continued to trust the story, even though he tried to make the story happen himself.
  - · HE INTRODUCED HIS WIFE AS HIS SISTER.
  - HE WAS IMPATIENT IN WAITING FOR A SON.
  - · HE THOUGHT HIS WIFE WAS TOO OLD TO HAVE A CHILD.
- Abraham was promised as many descendants as there are stars in the sky and sand on the shore.
  - o Abraham was impatient, but God remained faithful
- When Abraham was 99 years old and Sarah was 89, visitors from God came to Abraham and told him they would have a son by this time next year.
  - SARAH LAUGHED AT THE THOUGHT OF A 90 YEAR OLD GIVING BIRTH.
  - That time next year, Abraham and Sarah had Isaac.
- God kept his promise, even when Abraham made mistakes.
- When Isaac was grown, Abraham sent a servant back to his homeland to find a wife.
  - Abraham's servant found someone who displayed the same commitment to serving as Abraham did.
    - ABRAHAM TRUSTED THE STORY BY BEING PATIENT IN FINDING A WIFE FOR HIS SON WHO WOULD SHOW THE SAME VALUES GOD SAW IN HIM WHEN HE CALLED HIM TO FOLLOW.
  - o Isaac Married Rebekah.
- Even when the story seemed improbably (like a 90 year old woman giving birth), we see God's story is true and trustworthy.
