

CALL OF ABRAM

- THE WORD "BEGINNING" IN GENESIS 1:1 IS THE HEBREW WORD "RE'SHIYTH (RAY-SHEETH')" WHICH MEANS "FIRST, BEGINNING, BEST, CHIEF."
 - THE CREATION STORY WAS BOTH FIRST IN TIMELINE ORDER AND FIRST IN IMPORTANCE IN THE BIBLICAL NARRATIVE.
- After Creation, God saw that his creation was good. He trusted the story.
- Adam and Eve were the first humans and the only part of creation made "imago dei" or "in the image of God."
- After Adam and Eve sinned, God started working on a plan of redemption to bring his people back to him.
 - · HE SAVED NORTH AND HIS FAMILY DURING THE FLOOD.
 - HE REMINDED PEOPLE OF THEIR NEED FOR HIM AT BABEL.
- THE NEXT STEP IN THE REDEMPTION STORY WAS CREATING AN AVENUE TO BRING HIMSELF INTO THE WORLD IN A PHYSICAL WAY.
 - The Call of Abram was the first major step toward sending Jesus to us.
- It was borderline morally wrong in Abram's culture to follow the call of Yahweh.
 - Abram Left everything he ever knew.
 - HE LEFT HIS FATHER'S PROTECTION AND PROSPERITY.
 - He left his father's work.
 - He left his father's gods.
 - HE LEFT HIS INHERITANCE.
 - He left his honor.
 - Abram still followed God's call without hesitation
- GOD MADE A COVENANT WITH ABRAM TO BLESS THE NATIONS OF THE WORLD THROUGH HIM.
 - GOD WAS NOT INTERESTED IN ABRAM GETTING COMFORTABLE LIKE THE PEOPLE OF BABEL - HE WANTED ABRAM GOING TO BLESS THE WORLD.
 - O ABRAM SET UP AN ALTAR FOR GOD. SHOWING GOD'S IMMOVABILITY.
 - HE PITCHED A TENT FOR HIMSELF, SHOWING HIS FLEXIBILITY TO FOLLOW.
