

BASKET BARY

- THE WORD "BEGINNING" IN GENESIS 1:1 IS THE HEBREW WORD "RE'SHIYTH (RAY-SHEETH')" WHICH MEANS "FIRST, BEGINNING, BEST, CHIEF."
 - THE CREATION STORY WAS BOTH FIRST IN TIMELINE ORDER AND FIRST IN IMPORTANCE IN THE BIBLICAL NARRATIVE.
- After Creation, God saw that his creation was good. He trusted the story.
- ABRAHAM TRUSTED THE STORY AND FOLLOWED GOD.
 - Because Abraham followed God, he was given a son, Isaac, who had sons, Esau and Jacob.
 - JACOB WAS BLESSED AND HAD 12 SONS, WHICH WOULD BECOME THE 12 TRIBES OF ISRAEL.
 - EVENTUALLY, ISRAEL SETTLED IN EGYPT WHERE THEY WERE SLAVES FOR 400 years.
- PHARAOH WAS SCARED THE ISRAELITES WERE BECOMING TOO GREAT TO BE CONTROLLED. HE WAS SCARED OF A REVOLT FROM THE SLAVES!
 - In order to control their numbers, he made an evil law that required every Israelite baby boy to be thrown in the Nile River to drown.
- God heard his people crying out, and sent Moses to save them.
 - Jochabed had a son and couldn't do what Pharaoh commanded.
 Instead, she kept him hidden as long as she could.
 - After her son got too big to hide (and probably too loud),
 Jochabed made a basket and placed her son in the basket and placed the basket in the Nile River
 - TECHNICALLY, SHE IRONICALLY FOLLOWED THE LAW.
- God kept Moses safe until Pharaoh's own daughter saw a basket in the river.
 - PHARADH'S DAUGHTER HAD SOMEONE FETCH THE BASKET AND FOUND THE BABY INSIDE.
 - o She adopted the baby and named him Moses ("drawn dut").
 - o Moses grew up in Pharadh's household.
