

## JOSEPH AND HIS BROS

- THE WORD "BEGINNING" IN GENESIS 1:1 IS THE HEBREW WORD "RE'SHIYTH (RAY-SHEETH')" WHICH MEANS "FIRST, BEGINNING, BEST, CHIEF."
  - THE CREATION STORY WAS BOTH FIRST IN TIMELINE ORDER AND FIRST IN IMPORTANCE IN THE BIBLICAL NARRATIVE.
- After Creation, God saw that his creation was good. He trusted the story.
- ABRAHAM TRUSTED THE STORY AND FOLLOWED GOD.
  - Because Abraham followed God, he was given a son, Isaac, who had sons. Esau and Jacob.
  - JACOB WAS BLESSED AND HAD 12 SONS, WHICH WOULD BECOME THE 12 TRIBES OF ISRAEL.
- Jacob favored his son, Joseph, above his other 11 sons.
  - o Joseph was the oldest of Jacob's favorite wife, Rachel.
- Joseph had dreams his brothers would bow down to him.
  - O HIS BROTHERS BECAME RESENTFUL OF HIM.
- · JACOB MADE JOSEPH A COLORFUL ROBE.
  - o His brothers resented him even more and threw him in a pit.
    - Later, they sold him into slavery.
- Joseph's Brothers Dipped Joseph's Robe in Goat blood and showed it to Jacob.
  - o Jacob concluded his son had been killed by animals.
- Joseph was sold to a man named Potiphar and became the head of his household as a slave.
  - After being falsely accused of something, Joseph was thrown into prison.
    - WHILE IN PRISON, JOSEPH INTERPRETED DREAMS OF THE PHARAOH'S CUPBEARER AND BAKER.
- When Pharroh heard about Joseph's ability to interpret dreams, he called for Joseph.
- Joseph, with the power of God, interpreted Pharaoh's dream and became second in command in all of Egypt.
