What to expect:

- Diving into our Bibles; what it is and how to break it down and navigate through it to find our memory verse or Bible story.
- Reading/listening to/watching a Bible story using creative methods (lights out and read with flashlight, clap twice when a certain word is said, a video of the story, listen to scripture in form of a song, etc.)
- Engaging in lively discussion of the story; the who, what, when, where and how we can apply or allow it to affects our lives.
- Using a form of art to experience and reinforce the story. Cooking, crafting, painting, sculpting and scientific experiments are just a few mediums used.
- Ending class with a few thoughts to strengthen the memory of the story and a prayer.
