Small Group Q's

- Where have you seen or heard the message to look after number one, stack up your paper, get yours, or otherwise just get as much as you can and take care of yourself before others?
- Jesus's parable in Luke 12:13-21 teaches about the rich fool. What was the fool's occupation? What was the issue he had? Why was his solution to build bigger barns bad?
- Name something that someone can own right now that is important in the Kingdom of heaven (you probably can't).
- When the Kingdom of God is established on earth, no physical things will matter. Getting everything now gets you nothing later. You can invest in your future, though, and lay up treasures in heaven. What does that mean? How can you do that?
- The rich fool focused too much on having too much. When his soul was taken, those barns were useless. How could he have used his time on earth more wisely?
- What is something you worry over? How does knowing God "clothes" the fields with flowers and feeds the ravens bring you comfort?
- "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also." How do we shift our focus to legitimately treasure the Kingdom of heaven?
